



Driving Range rules

Please read carefully

The purpose of the driving range is for players to practice, learn and enjoy golf.

- No drivers. Please keep all shots inside the boundaries of the driving range and **avoid any shots that land near the second tee box.**
- No club sharing. Each player must have their own equipment
- No bay sharing. Each player must have their own bay and have paid for a basket of balls.
- Maximum of 10 persons on the range. Exception being the golf professional when coaching or juniors under supervision
- Under 17's must be supervised by an adult golfer except for members of recognised golf clubs or undergoing tuition (our professional, Gary Leslie offers lessons for juniors and adults – please see the end of this document for prices). If asked for proof of membership/age, ID needs to be presented.
- Anyone under the age of 18 needs to book in at the golf reception before using the range.
- No loitering on the range. Please leave once you have finished.
- No dangerous behaviour. Swing safely and only on the mat situated in each bay.
- Please be courteous toward other users. Avoid bad, loud, and offensive language. Take phone calls outside of the range area. Please do not play music
- Always give priority to staff at Welton Manor GC, including the greenkeepers and golf professional
- When balls are being collected, under no circumstance hit your shots near the greens staff
- The far two end bays are priority to the golf professional
- Only coaching by Welton Manor GC professional is permitted
- No hitting from the grass with the exception of the golf professional or by prior permission
- No collecting balls from the range. Please purchase golf balls from the machine



Driving range rules continued



- Do not litter. Please use bins provided. Only food and drinks purchased from the club can be consumed on the range.
- No bicycles or scooters on the range, please use bike racks provided at your own risk.
- No persons on or around the range area after 9pm summertime. This time alters throughout the year.
- Do not take any balls from the range off-site. Return your basket to the golf reception.
- CCTV in operation at all times

Should any of the above rules be ignored you will be asked to leave immediately with any golf balls purchased and not used returned to WMGC without a refund. If you are challenged by anyone regarding the above rules, please be respectful. Any abuse or foul language toward other golfers, staff or our golf professional will result in a ban.

We actively encourage new golfers therefore we strongly advise beginners to undertake lessons. Our golf professional, Gary Leslie offers golf lessons from the very beginner to scratch players. His prices are as follows:

Junior coaching prices

Under 12 - 30 minutes individual coaching - £15

Age 12-18 - 30 minutes individual coaching - £18

Age 18-21 in higher education 40 minutes individual coaching - £25

Adult coaching prices

30 minutes individual coaching = from £25
