Winter rules

We would like to take the opportunity to reiterate the importance of complying with the Winter rules we sent out to you at the beginning of the Winter season. It is imperative these rules are followed to protect the course as much as possible during the Winter months so they can be in the best condition possible throughout the season.

We are encouraging you to use mats, however this is optional and down to personal preference. I have added a link to some recommended golf mats from Spurk.

Golf trolleys

After much consideration and deliberation, we have ultimately decided to implement a ban on electric trolleys unless they have hedgehog wheels. This will be effective as of 1st February until further notice. The reasons behind this is because the heavy electric trolleys cause compaction and immense damage, particularly in very wet areas. We are not completely banning electric trolleys; we are just kindly asking you to consider the course and invest in some hedgehog wheels. We would prefer all golfers to use a lightweight bag on a small trolley with hedgehog wheels or to carry their bag would be even more beneficial to protect the course. We understand it is not ideal, however, it will hugely benefit the course throughout the year which in turn, benefits yourselves.

Treasury

Jacqui produced a comprehensive report at the association meeting outlining revenue and expenditure within the club, which was agreed by all parties present. A count was done and there is currently £385 in the Captain's Charity pots for Prostate Cancer that are located on the bar and on the golf reception, with most of it accumulating from lose change, and over £100 being collected from the January quiz night.

Seniors correspondence/volunteering

We were pleased to receive a series of questions from the Seniors section regarding the course and the club. We thought members would find it useful to read the questions and responses as many of the points raised may be relevant to all our members, therefore they have been attached to this email for your perusal. The greenkeepers are exceptionally busy prioritising maintaining the course, therefore making smaller miscellaneous jobs difficult to carry out due to time constraints. We are looking for volunteers to help do a few odd jobs, something which members have usually done in previous years. Volunteering duties that need doing are:

- Painting the tee markers and out of bounds posts etc.
- Wiping tee information boards etc.
- Picking up litter as and when you see it
- Cleaning and maintaining the halfway house

When the halfway house was built it was a joint venture between the golf club and the membership with an agreement that the duties of maintaining the halfway house would also be the responsibility of the members. We will supply any cleaning supplies/toilet roll etc. however, as the ladies have successfully organised, a rota needs drawing up of who can do what and when.

Please get in touch with us if you wish to volunteer your services, it will not only be appreciated by us, but by the entire club and visitors too.

Honours boards

We are in the process of ordering honours boards, and we are aiming for these to be engraved and installed before the season begins.

WhatsApp group

We have a WhatsApp group whereby daily course information is communicated by the management team to the members, and members use it to organise rounds of golf with one another. Any questions members have can also be quickly answered. It has proved a great success with the members who are already in it.
